School Reward System

At TGPA Haselor, we celebrate the children's successes daily. You may have heard your child mention the TG Rewards or seen a collection of stickers appearing in the back of their planner?

TG Rewards is our very own rewards system designed to celebrate and reward the achievement of our students.

How does it work?

Students are awarded a TG reward to celebrate many successes including: producing a fantastic piece of work; putting in a huge amount of effort in class or demonstrating exemplary behaviour around the Academy. Children can also receive house points from members of staff.

The children then stick their TG award in their planner and visit: www.mystickers.co.uk to log their awards on to their account.

Children can then build up their points and once they reach different milestones, they receive a badge to wear on their blazer.

Class 2 are also currently trialling Class Dojo Awards to run alongside the TG awards. Children have their own Avatar and are awarded points for different successes. The children particularly enjoy looking at their Avatars and watching their points grow!

The children share in these successes on a Friday morning in assembly. The Year 6 House Captains announce the new house point totals and these are displayed in the library for all to see.

In our celebration assembly, children can also receive an achievement certificate each week. If your child receives one of these certificates, they are automatically awarded 10 house points!
