I am delighted to let you know that our class teachers at Haselor for September remain the same as this year and so we will have:

Children will spend the whole day in their 'September Class' and new Reception pupils are joining us for the day, where possible, too. **Year 6 children who are going to Alcester Academy** in September have their transition activities online for the day at home and are not expected in school at Haselor that day. **All other children in year 6** are expected to attend as normal on the 9<sup>th</sup> July and will be working with me in the Forest School area for the day and can come to school in old clothes and wellies / old shoes.

I do need to inform you that we are sad to be saying '**farewell**' to **Mrs Hamilton** who has decided to hang up her Specialist PE Teacher trainers at Haselor in order to concentrate on her other work commitments. We have been extremely grateful for her commitment to sporting activities at Haselor over the years and will miss her enthusiasm and passion for sport enormously. We are happy to say that she will continue to support and oversee our participation in Marathon Kids each week as we continue to be dedicated to maintaining and encouraging pupils' physical activity each day. I would personally like to thank Sophie for her hard work during her time at Haselor and for the development of sports provision that she has organised for all pupils.
