## Weekly update.

Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome back to Haselor after the Christmas break. This is only a short term with 5 weeks up until the February break but there is lots packed in so please ensure that you keep an eye on the dates list to see everything that is happening.

Class 4 have started their swimming sessions at Stratford pool on Tuesdays already. Children must have their coats for the visits and we recommend all children also having goggles to wear and an extra snack for after each of the sessions. On Saturday 20th January the next Cross Country meeting for Years 3-6 is taking place at Stratford High School. All children in these years are welcome to come and experience the event regardless of whether they have been able to attend previously please let the office know by Wednesday 17th at the latest if your child is able to attend. Children in Years 3 and 4 usually run first so need to arrive around 9.30am but the year 5 and 6 races are later and so children in these year groups should arrive around 10.30am. Many thanks for your support with this event.

The bookings for children in Wraparound Care are increasingly high which is excellent. We do have to adhere to firm safety ratios for the numbers of children allowed in any one session, so please ensure that all children are booked in via the MCAS app before arrival- especially if you are booking in more than one child. If you are unable to book it is usually due to the places being full as we cannot take more that 20 children in each session. If you book several session in advance (which is highly recommended) do please let us know if your child will not be attending a session for whatever reason, so that this place can be offered to someone else who might need it. As always if you have any problems booking sessions, please do contact the school office.


