Class 3 Spring Term

As users of English... we will be studying the story of *Romulus and Remus* and other ancient myths. In the second half term, we will be diving into a novel study of *Who Let the Gods Out* by Maz Evans.

As users of maths... we will be strengthening our understanding of measurement calculating length, perimeter and area. We will also be developing our use of fractions and decimals, including rounding decimals. We will be growing our understanding of multiplication and division.

As creative artists... we will be exploring Ancient Roman Art, which includes painting, sculpture, architecture and mosaic work.

As scientific enquirers... we will be researching the nutritional requirements of animals, including humans and investigating how animals use their skeletons and muscles for movement. In the second half term, we will be investigating the key concepts of light sources, how we see and how light travels in straight lines.

As historical enquirers... we will be researching the Roman Empire and its impact on Britain. We will look at change during the time of Ancient Rome, from Kingdom to the dissolution of the Empire.

As moral and spiritual beings... we will be developing our understanding of different beliefs, answering the key questions 'What do different people believe about God?' and 'Why is the Bible important for Christians today?'

As geographical enquirers... we will be linking with our History unit of work to explore the span and settlements of the Ancient Roman Empire. We will be researching the legacy of the Roman Empire and the impact of this on the roads and cities of Britain.

As users of technology... we will be consolidating our knowledge of online safety and developing our understanding of how to handle data in a variety of programmes.

As practical problem solvers... we will be learning how to make bread.
