Weekly update.

Dear Parents/Carers,

The next **Friends of Haselor meeting** is on Thursday 22nd February at 7.00pm. Parents meet to discuss future events to be held for the children and families at school - all welcome- location to be confirmed nearer the time.

We were very lucky to win a grant to develop outdoor spaces within school last year. The **School Council** gained feedback from classes which said that children would like a mindfulness quiet area within school to be able to access during breaktimes if needed. As a result, we now have a sandpit, tough tray with Duplo bricks, a toy tray and outdoor' Connect 4' for children to access in the **Courtyard area**. We are looking at adding some art-work to the brick wall to further enhance the area. Do come and have a look when you are next in school.

All children from years 1-6 have access to **Times Table Rock Stars** online to support their learning of times-tables at home and in school. Children in **Year 4 undertake a Multiplication Tables Check** in June to assess their ability.

Evidence has shown that children who frequently revisit the learning of their times-tables retain them better and that this positively supports their math's attainment. We monitor 'TTRockstars' use in school and recommend that children undertake practice **three times a week** for 5-10 minutes. If your child has a problem logging in, please contact the office or your child's class teacher. We have only had one parent so far confirm that they are going to attend the **parent online safety workshop** on the 6th February at 6pm.
